Indoor Summer Maintenance

Air Conditioning Units

- Clean or replace filters every 1–3 months.
- Clean your evaporator and condenser coils.
- Straighten your coil fins using a fin tool.

- Ensure your outdoor unit is shaded but not obstructed.

Ceiling Fans

- Adjust your fan rotation to run counterclockwise.
- Clean your fan blades with a damp cloth.

Plumbing

- Check for water damage around sinks, toilets, showers, etc.
- Use a water pressure gauge to measure water pressure it should be between 40-60 psi.

Smoke and CO2 Detectors

- Test your units to make sure they're in working order.
- Replace batteries in all detectors throughout the home.

Pest Control

- Check for signs of rodents, ants, termites, etc. droppings, chew marks, nests.
- Check your food storage and use airtight containers to store grains, pet food, and dry goods.
